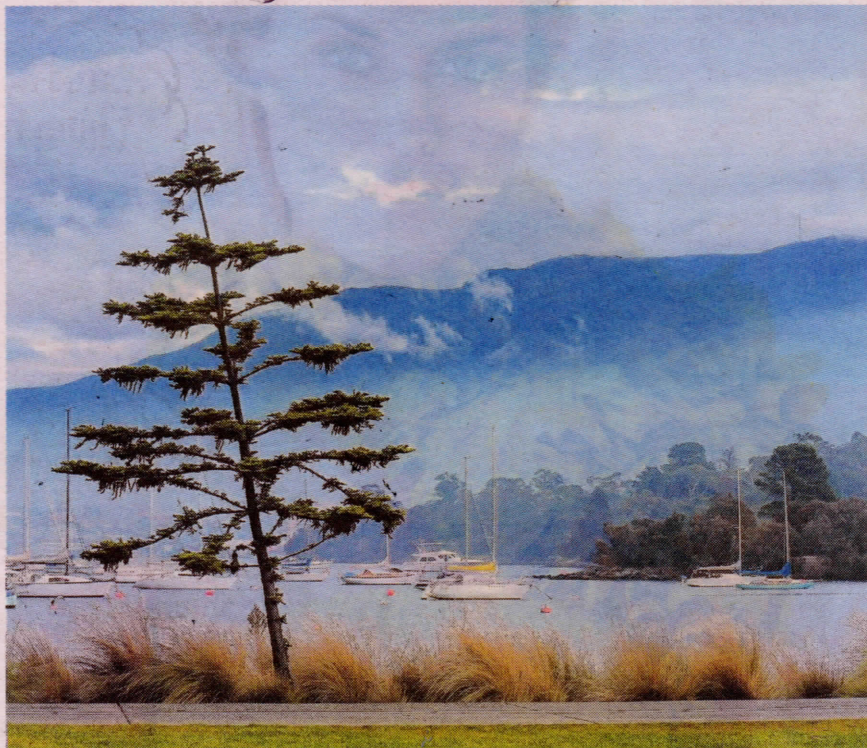


Listen to Clarence residents
